FirstNet is a network that is the result of a 25- year contract between AT&T and the Dept. of Commerce FirstNet® **Authority** Public Safety Stakeholders

The <u>contract</u> creates a network that is <u>more accountable</u>, focused and transparent to public safety <u>than any other cellular network</u> in the US

WHAT ABOUT THE COST?

Console integration is a one-time cost, and will vary based on the number of shared resources

- AT&T costs estimated at \$20,000
 - Based on the number of talkgroups needed roughly 8
 - No network software/hardware upgrade nor maintenance fees
 - More advanced connections are available if desired and supported (e.g. +PTT-IDs, +Emergency)

Cost Per User = Device + Connectivity + Application

- Connectivity and Application fees are based on a Monthly Reoccurring Charge (MRC)
- Device can be a one-time cost, or rolled into the MRC as well
